

Equality and Diversity Policy

- 1. Children/parents/carers who attend the group to be treated with dignity and respect at all times regardless of their sex, race, culture, religion, age, ability or disability.
- 2. All parents/carers/leaders to encourage children to use any equipment they wish to and not to stereotype.
- 3. All parents/carers to be encouraged to help with the group where and when everyone's opinions will be valued.
- 4. Helpers are to ensure equal access to all equipment.
- 5. Equipment and play activities to be adapted where possible to enable participation of children or adults with physical disabilities or learning difficulties.
- 6. Activities and resources should reflect the society we live in.
- 7. Refreshments provided take into account children's/carers diet, religion and culture as appropriate.
- 8. Reasonable adjustment should be made to provide disability access e.g. space for wheelchair users.
- 9. Racist and/or sexist remarks are not acceptable and will be challenged.
- 10. The leader should be made aware of any remarks causing offence to any group members.
- 11. Reassurance, comfort and support should be given to any children who have been hurt by unwanted comments or behaviour.
- 12. The leader will speak to any member heard to be making unacceptable remarks in a nonaggressive way, reiterating the group's policy, practice and the law.
