Hygiene Policy

- 1. Parents/carers should take children to the toilets to change nappies (the disabled toilet has a changing shelf). Changing nappies on the carpeted areas is not allowed.
- 2. All soiled nappies to be placed in the nappy bucket in the disabled toilet.
- 3. All helpers to wash hands before and after preparing drinks and food.
- 4. All work surfaces to be cleaned before and after use.
- 5. If a child is sick, the child should be comforted by the parent/carer and removed from the area. The leader and or helper should ensure the area is thoroughly cleaned and disinfected, wearing disposable gloves.
- 6. All parents and carers to be encouraged to bring in their own child's drinking cup. Cups used frequently often get chewed by young children and are difficult to keep clean.
